

## Regulations of the Use of SDGSAT-1 Data

Sustainable Development Science Satellite 1 (SDGSAT-1), developed and operated by the International Research Center of Big Data for Sustainable Development Goals (CBAS), is the world's first science satellite dedicated to serving the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. In order to maximize the scientific values of SDGSAT-1, the data acquired by SDGSAT-1 will be available to the scientific community globally free-of-charge through SDGSAT-1 Open Science Program ([www.sdgsat.ac.cn](http://www.sdgsat.ac.cn)).

CBAS grants access to SDGSAT-1 data for the purpose of scientific research only. In order to regulate the usage of SDGSAT-1 data, and ensure its rational utilization and data security, the specific regulations are as follows.

1. The copyright of SDGSAT-1 belongs to CBAS. All data from SDGSAT-1 satellite is protected by copyright, owned and controlled by CBAS.
2. All contents of the SDGSAT-1 Open Science System website are intended for non-commercial use. CBAS grants permission to users to visit the site, and to download and copy information, images, documents and materials from the website for non-commercial use. CBAS does not grant the right to sell or redistribute any information, documents, images or materials from its website or to compile or create derivative works from materials on its website. All materials published on the SDGSAT-1 Open Science System website are protected by copyright owned by CBAS.
3. The SDGSAT-1 data can only be used for scientific research. The users are not allowed to spread SDGSAT-1 data without permission.
4. The outcomes generated by SDGSAT-1 data should explicitly indicate that the data source is from SDGSAT-1. The related publications, such as papers, books and press releases, should acknowledge CBAS for providing the data, preferably as "it is acknowledged that the SDGSAT-1 data are kindly provided by CBAS". Copyright in any derivative materials (e.g., software and remote sensing product) must credit "CBAS".
5. The user agrees to these terms by using SDGSAT-1 data and waives any claims for damages against CBAS and other information providers. Dispute resolution processes in courts, arbitration, as well as contracts and torts, are all included in the range of conflicts that this waiver is intended to cover.
6. CBAS has the right to terminate data usage for users if it deems that the provided data is being used against its policy and regulations.
7. CBAS reserves the right to explain the regulations.
